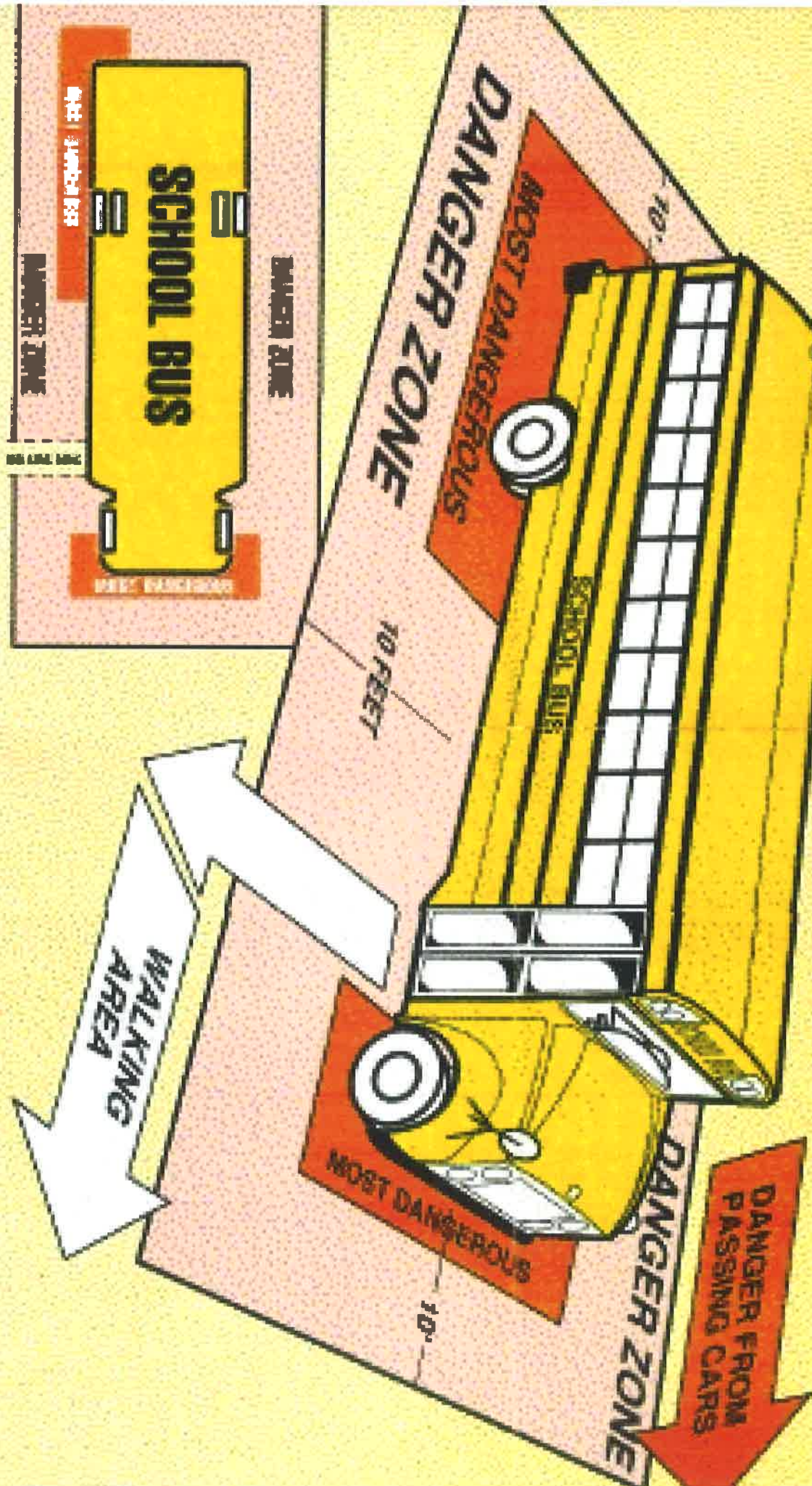


SCHOOL BUS SAFETY RULES



- 1. Follow driver's instructions.**
- 2. Always SIT DOWN.**
- 3. Be respectful. No fighting, swearing or yelling.**
- 4. No EATING or DRINKING.**
- 5. Keep your head and arms inside the bus windows.**
- 6. Windows may not be open over halfway.**
- 7. Stay out of the "DANGER ZONES" outside the bus.**

Student-Rules must be enforced

- All Drivers are to inform the students of the following rules and then enforce these rules.
 1. Students are not to walk towards your vehicle until it is stopped and the door is open.
 2. No student is allowed to eat or drinking in any company vehicle.
 3. Seat belts are to be worn properly by all passengers, if the vehicle is equipped
 4. Students must remain seated while the vehicle is in motion.
 5. Grades K-3rd grade sit in the front of the vehicle. First 4 rows of seats.
 6. Elementary students are to have assigned seats.
 7. Students must be seated in the following manor.-Seat to Seat- Back to Back-with Voice and Hands to themselves.
 8. Nothing blocking the aisle of the buses, including student's feet, backpacks and band instruments.
 9. All audio listening devices used by students must use a headphones/ear buds at a personable level.
 10. Students are not to touch emergency equipment, including sleeping child alarms.
 11. If students are **not** ready to ride (cannot be transported safely). Notify dispatch and the district office will be contacted for permission to leave the student behind.
 12. Inform students how to use the Emergency **Hatch and Windows** work in case of emergency and what to do if you are incapacitated.. Shut off the vehicle and turn the key to Accessory-Radio for help and give Bus Number and exact
